# Now Is The Time To Sign Up And Start Playing!

Students entering the 5<sup>th</sup>grade have the opportunity to learn to play a musical instrument. The SASD offers instrumental music instruction to students beginning in the 5<sup>th</sup> grade continuing through 12<sup>th</sup> grade.

Your child has or will be attending a demonstration of the band & string instruments at school. During this time, students are encouraged to ask questions about playing an instrument and about the instrument choices they may be interested in. Please take a few minutes to discuss playing an instrument with your child.

#### How much does it cost?

Instruments may be rented from the SASD for a yearly rental fee of \$20.00.

If the instrument your child wants to play is not available through the SASD, you may rent or purchase an instrument from a local music store. Please be aware that there are limited quantities of certain instruments available to rent from the SASD. If there is a shortage of a particular instrument, that instrument will be assigned through a lottery. Be assured that all students will be able to play an instrument in which they are interested in AND can be successful at!

#### Other costs include:

- Lesson book \$10.00
- Other supplies \$10.00 -\$20.00 (depending on instrument choice)

## If your child wants to play, We will find a way!

**Please note:** If there are financial concerns relating to these costs that would prevent your child from playing an instrument, please let your band/string teacher know and they will work with you.

#### Is There A Time Commitment?

Students are expected to practice at home between their weekly lessons. The amount of time a child practices directly relates to their progress, enjoyment and success. Playing an instrument well requires both commitment and responsibility. These are beneficial qualities for all students to develop!

## How Do I Sign Up?

Students who want to participate in band or strings need to return this sign-up form to their classroom teacher by the deadline indicated.

These students will then have the opportunity to "try out" a few different instruments. This try-out session is needed to determine which instrument(s) are a good match for your child based on his/her instrument interest and matching physical characteristics (lip structure, finger/hand size, braces). Your child and instrumental music teacher will pick an instrument together. This process will help to ensure a positive instrument match and playing experience for your child.
